Please get your record checks completed and to the office as soon as possible. Teachers will be asking for those checks before accepting volunteers in their classrooms. 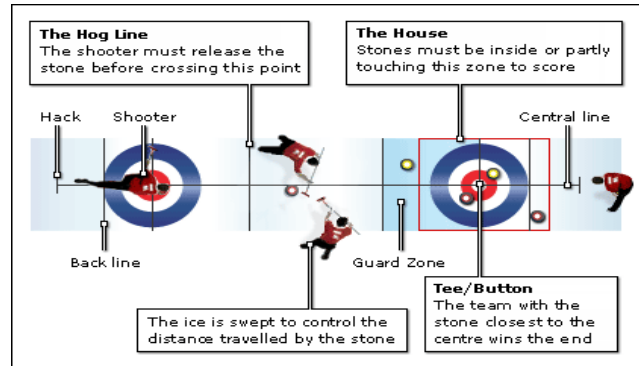
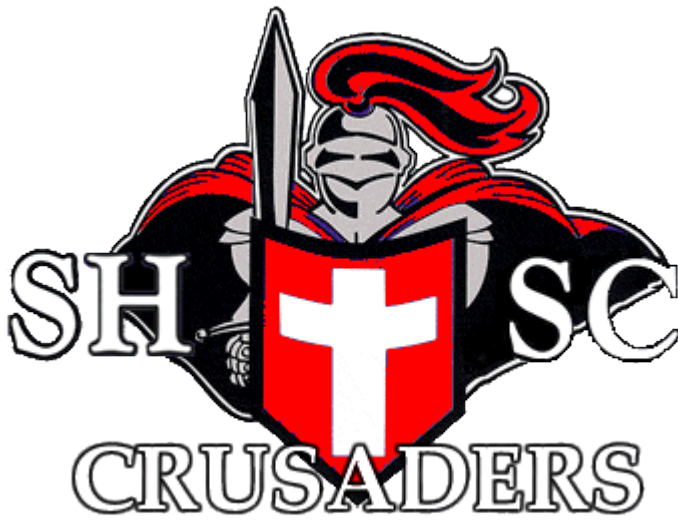
